PSSA PLAYER'S CODE:

- 1. Play for the fun of it.
- 2. Compete by the rules and always listen to the referees, umpires or touch judges.
- 3. Control your frustration. Make no criticism either by word or gesture.
- 4. Work equally hard for yourself and for your team: Your team's performance will benefit and so will your own.
- 5. Be willing to train and prepare for the game. Preparation helps prevent injury and increases the level of enjoyment.
- 6. Play only when you are fully fit. To play with an injury will handicap your team and may expose you to the risk of serious life long injury.
- 7. Be a good sport. Encourage team members.
- 8. At all times, cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them you do not have a competition.
- 9. When on the sideline, remain seated and in the view of the teacher, be respectful, listen to instructions and support the team in play.
- 10. Remain at school during PSSA when I have demonstrated unsafe, disrespectful, disruptive or harmful behaviour at school or at PSSA.
- 11. Participation is a privilege and not a right.
- 12. Remember the goals of the game are to have fun and improve your skills. Be modest in success and generous in defeat.
