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NON-LOCAL HIGH SCHOOL

There may be additional documentation required for applications to attend a school outside your catchment zone.

Check with each out-of-area high school to confirm application requirements and cut-off dates.



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STRONG REASONS

- Siblings already enrolled (don't depend on this alone!)
- Proximity or access (e.g. safety, supervision)
- Availability of subjects or programs that are not available at the local school
- Compassionate circumstances e.g. a child with disability
- Medical reasons
- Access to single-sex setting



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REASONS THEY WILL NOT ACCEPT

- I went there and have an emotional attachment
- We've heard great things
- My child's best friend is going there
- Results on MySchools website impressed me
- My child has heart set on going there
- Google reviews are better than our local schools'



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SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION FOR OUT-OF-AREA EOI

Supporting documentation is not accepted. Each school lists its considerations and parents must address those criteria. When making their decision, a school may ask for supporting documentation.

Only when the parent completes the full application can they add attachments.

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PLACEMENT NOT REQUIRED

- Complete if you **do not** require a place in a government school or you have already accepted a place at a Catholic or Independent high school

Please advise your primary school if your child will not require a placement in a government high school next year.

Please note: The last day for submission is **31 October 2022**

Your primary school needs to know so they may support your child's transition and the department can fulfil its duty of care to all students.



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HOW TO ACCEPT AN OFFER OF PLACEMENT

When a high school has offered a student a placement for Year 7, an email is sent to the parent/carer with a link to the high school's enrolment page on their website.

Parents must complete this enrolment form and attach additional documents.



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YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

Complete and submit the EOI by 28TH MARCH

Once accepted into a high school, it is your responsibility to communicate with your child's high school about:

- Learning and support needs (academic, social, emotional)
- Health and medical needs (e.g. anaphylaxis, epilepsy, asthma, diabetes)
- Current court orders
- High school information night, orientation, transition programs (primary schools are not always informed)
