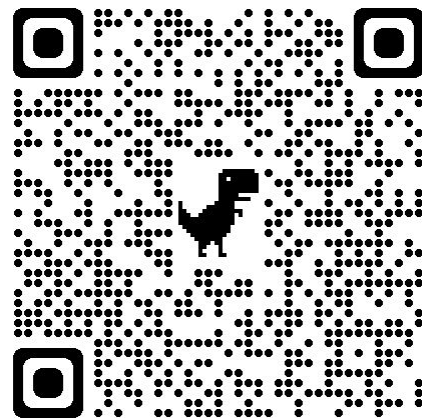

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# COMMUNICATION

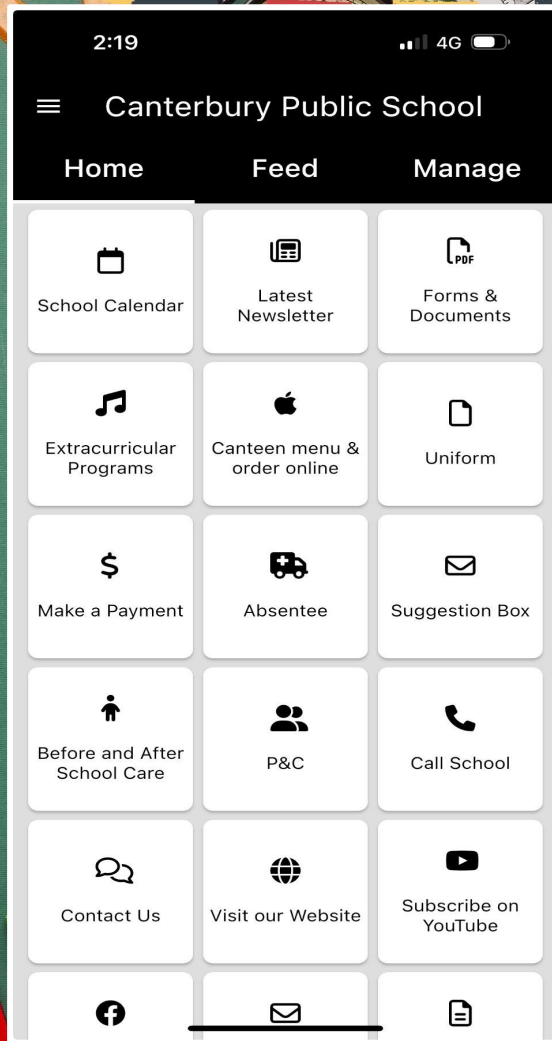
- Discuss child's progress – email the teacher to arrange a time

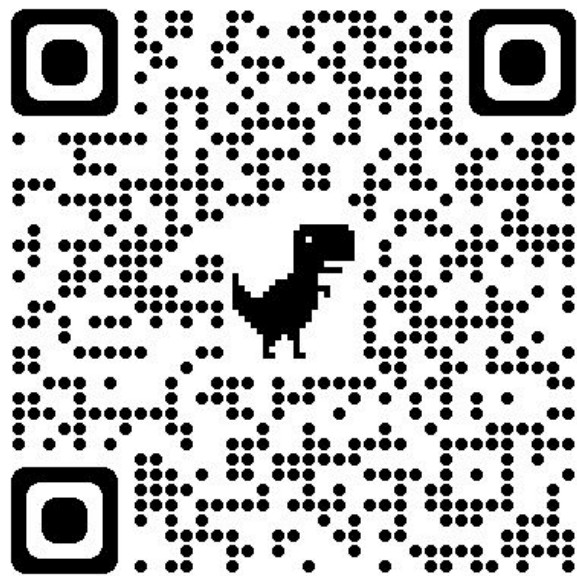

- Every 25 nights of reading, students return their reading log to go into the draw to win a book prize
- Students log their reading each night in this reading diary








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# COUNTING CARD

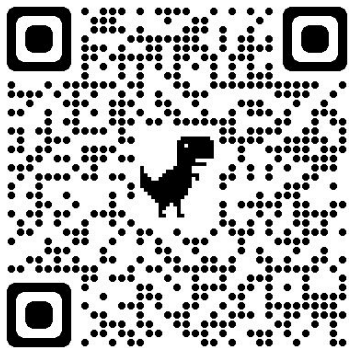




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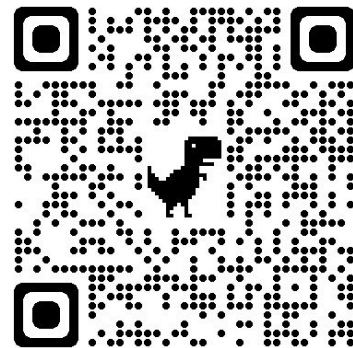

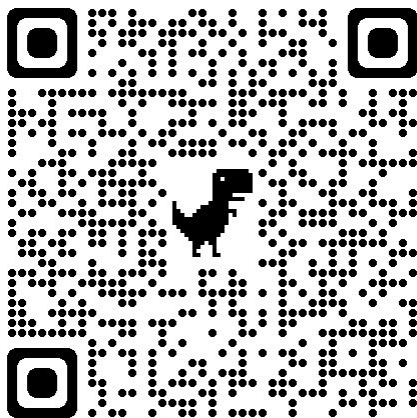




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# CLASS CONNECT

- Encourage age-appropriate independence and responsibility (e.g. homework, bag packed, punctuality)

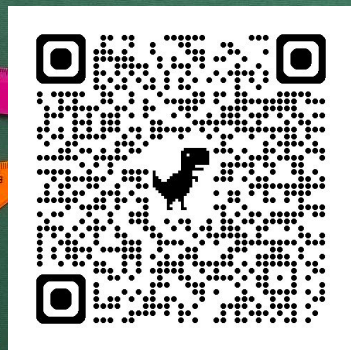




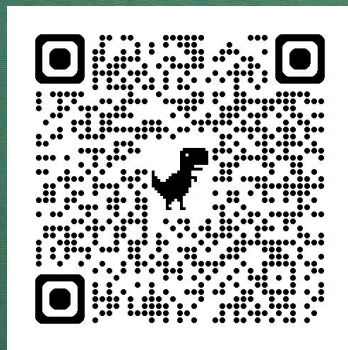
