Activity Name: Swim Scheme			
Date/Time:	Monday 1 September 2025 1:00pm - Friday 12 September 2025 2:30pm (Support Unit students lesson is at 1:00 - 1:45pm, Mainstream students lesson is at 1:45 - 2:30pm)		
Description:	Students in Years 2–6 who have expressed interest will participate in a 10-day Swimming and Water Safety Program held at Anette Kellerman Pool. This program aims to develop students' water confidence, enhance stroke technique and teach vital water safety and survival skills. It is particularly focused on supporting non-swimmers and those with developing skills.		
	Students will be grouped according to ability, allowing swimming instructors to deliver targeted, progressive instruction. Progress is closely monitored, with achievements formally recognised through a Certificate of Achievement issued at the end of the program.		
	Due to rising costs of buses and pool entry costs, the overall price for the program unfortunately has increased. The Department of Education is generously covering the cost of the swimming lessons and trained staff.		
	PLEASE NOTE: If your child is attending Stage 3 camp or PSSA sport on Fridays, they will not attend swimming on those days. Please be aware that the program fee remains the same regardless of how many sessions your child attends.

Educational Outcomes:  The aim of PE K-6 is to empower students with the essential knowledge, understar values and attitudes to promote wellbeing and lead a safe, active and healthy life.			
Additional Information:	Students do NOT need to wear their swimmers underneath their uniform as the swimming lesson is later in the day. Students will be given adequate time to change before arriving at the pool. They will then change back into school uniform after their lesson at the pool.		
	Normal school shoes MUST be worn to school each day and slip on shoes packed in their swimming bag.
